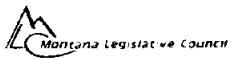

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 10-3-312, MCA, is amended to read:
 12 "10-3-312. Maximum expenditure in biennium. Whenever
 13 an emergency or disaster is declared by the governor, there
 14 is statutorily appropriated to the office of the governor,
 15 as provided in 17-7-502, and he is authorized to expend from
 16 the general fund, an amount not to exceed \$1 \$1.5 million in
 17 any one biennium."

18 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. This act is
 19 effective on passage and approval.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Section 10-3-312, MCA, is amended to read:
12 "10-3-312. Maximum expenditure in biennium. Whenever
13 an emergency or disaster is declared by the governor, there
14 is statutorily appropriated to the office of the governor,
15 as provided in 17-7-502, and he is authorized to expend from
16 the general fund, an amount not to exceed \$± \$1.5 million in
17 any one biennium."

18 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. This act is
19 effective on passage and approval.
