BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Liability of nonprofit organizations for injuries suffered in sponsored amateur rodeo events. (1) No nonprofit organization sponsoring an amateur rodeo is liable for injuries suffered by a contestant as a result of his voluntary participation in a rodeo event except for injuries caused by a willful, wanton, or reckless act of the sponsoring organization or its employees.

- (2) For purposes of this section, a minor is considered to be in voluntary participation at a rodeo event if:
- 22 (a) he has provided written consent to participate in 23 the rodeo event; and
- 24 (b) the consent is approved by one of the minor's parents or by his legal guardian.
