4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT INCREASING THE TIME
 5 ALLOWED FOR A CITY OR TOWN TO FILE A FINANCIAL STATEMENT
 6 WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE; AND AMENDING SECTION
 7 7-6-4111, MCA."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 7-6-4111, MCA, is amended to read:

11 "7-6-4111. Annual financial statement. (1) Within 60
 12 180 days after the close of each fiscal year, the city or
 13 town clerk of each city and town must make out, in
 14 duplicate, a complete statement of the financial condition
 15 of the city or town for that fiscal year, showing:

16 (a) the indebtedness of the city or town, funded and
 17 floating; the amount of each class of indebtedness; and the
 18 amount of money in the treasury subject to the payment of
 19 each class of indebtedness;

20 (b) the amount of money received from taxes upon real
 21 and personal property;

22 (c) the amount of money received from fines,
 23 penalties, and forfeitures;

24 (d) the amount of money received from licenses;

25 (e) the amount of money received from all other

1 sources, each source and the amount received from it being
 2 shown separately;

3 (f) for each fund, the amount of money, if any, on
 4 hand at the beginning of the fiscal year, the amount
 5 received, and the amount paid out during the fiscal year;

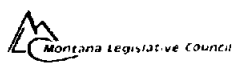
6 (g) a concise description of all property owned by the
 7 city or town, with an approximate estimate of the value of
 8 it;

9 (h) the rates of taxation and purposes for which taxes
 10 were levied during the fiscal year;

11 (i) other information which may be required by the
 12 department of commerce.

13 (2) The forms on which the statement shall be made
 14 shall be prescribed by the department."
