1 2 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO REQUIRE THE DRIVER OF A MOTOR VEHICLE TO YIELD TO PEDESTRIANS CROSSING THE ROADWAY WITHIN MARKED OR UNMARKED 6 CROSSWALKS 7 INTERSECTION; AND AMENDING SECTION 61-8-502, MCA." 8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 9 Section 1. Section 61-8-502, MCA, is amended to read: 10 11 "61-8-502. Pedestrians' right-of-way in crosswalk. (1) When traffic-control signals are not in place or not in 12 operation, the driver of a vehicle shall yield the 13 14 right-of-way, slowing down or stopping if need be to so 15 yield, to a pedestrian crossing the roadway within a marked crosswalk when-the--pedestrian--is--upon--the--half--of--the 16 roadway--upon--which--the--vehicle--is-traveling-or-when-the 17 pedestrian-is-approaching-so-closely-from-the-opposite--half 18 of--the--roadway--as--to--be-in-danger or within an unmarked 19 crosswalk at an intersection, but no pedestrian shall 20 suddenly leave a curb or other place of safety and walk or 21 run into the path of a vehicle which is so close that it is 22 impossible for the driver to yield. This provision shall not 23 apply under the conditions stated in 61-8-503(2). 24 (2) Whenever any vehicle is stopped at a marked 25

crosswalk or at any unmarked crosswalk at an intersection to 1 permit a pedestrian to cross the roadway, the driver of any other vehicle approaching from the rear shall not overtake 3 and pass such stopped vehicle.

(3) It is unlawful for any person to drive a motor vehicle through a column of school children crossing a street or highway or past a member of the school safety patrol while the member of the school safety patrol is directing the movement of children across a street or highway and while the school safety patrol member is holding his official signal in the stop position."
