5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ALLOW DRIVER RECORDS  
6 TO BE REPRODUCED ON FILM OR PLACED ON A COMPUTER STORAGE  
7 DEVICE; TO ESTABLISH THAT REPRODUCTIONS OF SUCH RECORDS  
8 PLACED ON A COMPUTER STORAGE DEVICE ARE CONSIDERED ORIGINALS  
9 AND ADMISSIBLE IN EVIDENCE; AND AMENDING SECTION 61-11-102,  
10 MCA."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13 Section 1. Section 61-11-102, MCA, is amended to read:  
14 "61-11-102. Records to be kept by the department. (1)  
15 The department shall file every application for a driver's  
16 license received by it and shall maintain suitable indexes  
17 containing, in alphabetical order:

18 (a) all applications denied and on each thereof note  
19 the reasons for such denial;

20 (b) all applications granted; and

21 (c) the name of every licensee whose license has been  
22 suspended or revoked by the department and after each such  
23 name note the reasons for such action.

24 (2) The department shall also file all accident  
25 reports and abstracts of court records of convictions

1 received by it under the laws of this state and in  
2 connection therewith maintain convenient records or make  
3 suitable notations in order that an individual record of  
4 each licensee showing the convictions of such licensee and  
5 certain traffic accidents in which he has been involved  
6 shall be readily ascertainable and available for the  
7 consideration of the department upon any application for  
8 renewal of license and at other suitable times. No record of  
9 involvement in a traffic accident may be entered on a  
10 licensee's record unless he was convicted, as defined in  
11 61-11-203, for an act causally related to the accident.

12 (3) The department is further authorized, upon  
13 receiving a record of the conviction in this state of a  
14 nonresident driver of a motor vehicle of any offense under

16 copy of such record to the motor vehicle administrator in  
17 the state wherein the person so convicted is a resident.

18 (4) The department may photograph, microphotograph,  
19 photostat, or reproduce on film any of its records. The  
20 film or reproducing material must be durable, and the device  
21 used to reproduce the records on the film or material must

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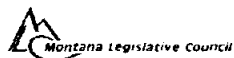
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
