In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB329, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This bill provides for a civil penalty for the illegal killing or possession of certain wildlife, birds, and fish; and provides for the disposition of these funds.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Estimates are based upon a three year average of the number of convictions received in Montana for the illegal killing or possession of wild birds, mammals and fish listed in this bill.
- 2. Estimate that 1/4 of the convictions will not result in a fine collection.
