 12 degree in a counseling field from an institution accredited
 13 to offer such a degree program;
- 14 (b) 2,000 hours or more of postdegree work experience 15 as a counselor in a hospital, school, agency, or other 16 supervised setting;
 - (c) and passed an examination prepared and administered by:
- 19 <u>(i)</u> the board, based on a national examination

The applicant must have each supervisor endorse his application for licensure, attesting to the number of hours supervised.
