(1) 14 The trustees of any district may propose to adopt a general 15 fund budget in excess of the general fund budget amount for 16 such district as established by the schedules in 20-9-31617 through 20-9-321 for any of the following purposes: 18 (a) building, altering, repairing, or enlarging any 19 schoolhouse of the district: 20 (b) furnishing additional school facilities for the 21 district: 22 (c) acquisition of land for the district; 23 (d) proper maintenance and operation of the school 24 programs of the district. 25 (2) When the trustees of any district determine that Montana Legislative Council
