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9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 20-4-204, MCA, is amended to read:
"20-4-204. Termination of tenure teacher services.
(1) (a) The following persons may make a recommendation in
writing to the trustees of the district for termination of
the services of a tenure teacher:

15 (i) a district superintendent;

16 (ii) in a district without a district superintendent, a
17 principal;

18 (iii) in a district without a district superintendent 19 or a principal, the county superintendent or a trustee of 20 the district.

(b) The recommendation must state clearly and
explicitly the specific reason or reasons leading to the
recommendation for termination.

(2) Whenever the trustees of a district receive arecommendation for termination, the trustees shall, before



April ± 15 of the current school fiscal year, notify the teacher of the recommendation for termination and of the teacher's right to a hearing on the recommendation. The notification must be delivered by certified letter or by personal notification for which a signed receipt is returned. The notification must include:

7 (a) the statement of the reason or reasons that led to8 the recommendation for termination; and

9 (b) a printed copy of this section for the teacher's 10 information.

11 (3) The teacher may, in writing, waive the right to a 12 hearing. Unless the teacher waives the right to a hearing, 13 the trustees shall set a hearing date, giving consideration 14 to the convenience of the teacher, not less than 10 days or 15 more than 20 days from receipt of the notice of 16 recommendation for termination.

17 (4) The trustees shall:

(a) conduct the hearing on the recommendation at a
regularly scheduled or special meeting of the board of
trustees and in accordance with 2-3-203; and

(b) resolve at the conclusion of the hearing to
terminate the teacher or to reject the recommendation for
termination.

24 (5) The tenure teacher may appeal a decision to25 terminate to the county superintendent who may appoint a

qualified attorney at law as legal adviser who shall assist
 the superintendent in preparing findings of fact and
 conclusions of law.

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4 (6) Subsequently, either the teacher or the trustees 5 may appeal to the superintendent of public instruction under 6 the provision for the appeal of controversies in this 7 title."

8 Section 2. Section 20-4-206, MCA, is amended to read: 9 "20-4-206. Notification of nontenure teacher 10 reelection -- acceptance -- termination and statement of reason. (1) The trustees shall provide written notice by 11 April 15 30 to all nontenure teachers who have been 12 reelected. Any nontenure teacher who does not receive notice 13 of reelection or termination shall be automatically 14 reelected for the ensuing school fiscal year. 15

16 (2) Any nontenure teacher who receives notification of 17 his reelection for the ensuing school fiscal year shall 18 provide the trustees with his written acceptance of the 19 conditions of such reelection within 20 days after the 20 receipt of the notice of reelection. Failure to so notify 21 the trustees within 20 days may be considered nonacceptance 22 of the tendered position.

(3) When the trustees notify a nontenure teacher of
 termination, the teacher may within 10 days after receipt of
 such notice make written request of the trustees for a

statement in writing of the reasons for termination of
 employment. Within 10 days after receipt of the request,
 the trustees shall furnish such statement to the teacher.

4 (4) The provisions of this section shall not apply to 5 cases in which a nontenure teacher is terminated when the 6 financial condition of the school district requires a 7 reduction in the number of teachers employed and the reason 8 for the termination is to reduce the number of teachers 9 employed."
