At the time the 16 sworn statement is filed, the purchaser or lender shall pay 17 to the department the assessment provided for in 80-11-206 18 19 for deposit in the wheat research and marketing barley account in the other special revenue funds. 20

21 (3) The statement referred to in subsections (1) and 22 (2) of this section shall be legibly written and shall be 23 entirely free of any corrections or erasures. A person may 24 not alter any part of a statement.

17 Section 4. Section 80-11-207, MCA, is amended to read: 18 "80-11-207. Buyer's delivery of invoice to grower ---19 form -- filing of sworn statement -- payment of assessment -- refund. (1) The purchaser of the wheat or barley at the 20 21 time of sale or the pledgee, mortgagee, or other lender at the time of the loan or advance shall give separate invoices 22 23 for each purchase to the grower. The invoices shall be on forms approved by the department and shall show: 24

25 (a) the name and address of the grower and seller;

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1 (b) the name and address of the purchaser or the 2 lender;

3 (c) the number of bushels of wheat or hundredweights
4 of barley sold, mortgaged, or pledged;

5 (d) the date of the purchase, mortgage, or pledge and 6 the amount of assessment collected and remitted to the 7 department.

8 (2) The purchaser, mortgagee, or pledgee shall file 9 with the department, on forms prescribed by the department, 10 within 20 days after the end of a month in which he purchases a grower's wheat or barley or in which a lender 11 makes a loan or advance on a grower's wheat or barley, a 12 sworn statement of the number of bushels of wheat or 13 hundredweights of barley purchased in Montana or the number 14 of bushels of wheat or hundredweights of barley mortgaged or 15 pledged or otherwise transferred or liened as security for a 16 loan during the preceding calendar month. At the time the 17 sworn statement is filed, the purchaser or lender shall pay 18 to the department the assessment provided for in 80-11-206 19 20 for deposit in the wheat research and marketing barley 21 account in the other special revenue funds.

(3) The statement referred to in subsections (1) and
(2) of this section shall be legibly written and shall be
entirely free of any corrections or erasures. A person may
not alter any part of a statement.

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1 (4) After 30 days and before 90 days following the 2 deduction of the assessment by the first purchaser or the first lender, the grower may, upon the submission of a 3 written, verified request to the department, obtain a refund 4 of the assessment. The request shall be accompanied by the 5 6 original invoices received by the grower at the time of 7 settlement. The department shall keep complete records of all refunds made under the provisions of this section. 8 9 Records of refunds may be destroyed 2 years after the refund 10 is made. All original invoices shall be returned to the 11 grower with the refund payment."

Section 5. Section 80-11-210, MCA, is amended to read: "80-11-210. Research Wheat and marketing barley account -- sources -- use -- expenditures. (1) There shall be an account in the other special revenue funds known as the wheat research and marketing barley account. The following shall be placed in the account:

18 (a) the proceeds of all millage levies collected under19 this part; and

(b) the proceeds from all gifts, grants, or donations
to the department for research authorized under this part.
(2) The account shall be maintained for the purposes
of this part and shall be separate from all other accounts
of the department.

25 (3) The department may direct the board of investments

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1 to invest funds from the account pursuant to the provisions 2 of the unified investment program for state funds. The 3 income from such investments shall be credited to the wheat 4 research and marketing barley account."

Section 6. Section 80-11-224, MCA, is amended to read:
"80-11-224. Determination of amount and allocation of
assessment. (1) The committee shall set the amount of the
assessment each year in accordance with 80-11-206.
