| 16 | chapter. Rulemaking procedures small comply with the |

| 18 | Section 2. Section 49-3-106, MCA, is amended to read: |
| 19 | "49-3-106. Rulemaking authority. The Subject to the |
| 20 | provisions of [section 3], the commission may adopt rules |

| 22 | accordance with the Montana Administrative Procedure Act. |
