10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Article XII, section 3, of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended to read:

"Section 3. Institutions and assistance. (1) The state shall establish and support institutions and facilities as the public good may require, including homes which may be necessary and desirable for the care of veterans.

- (2) Persons committed to any such institutions shall retain all rights except those necessarily suspended as a condition of commitment. Suspended rights are restored upon termination of the state's responsibility.
- (3) The legislature shall provide such economic assistance and social and rehabilitative services as may be necessary for those inhabitants who, by reason of age; infirmities; or misfortune may have need for the aid of

1 society." 2 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. If approved 3 by the electorate, this amendment is effective July 1, 1989. 4 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Submission to electorate. This amendment shall be submitted to the electors of Montana at the general election to be held November 8, 1988, by printing on the ballot the full title of this act and the 8 following: 9 FOR eliminating age as a qualification for economic 10 assistance and governmental services. 11 AGAINST eliminating age as a qualification for 12 economic assistance and governmental services. -End-

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to submit to the electors of Montana an amendment to Article XII, Section 3, of the Montana Constitution to eliminate age as a qualification for economic assistance and governmental services; and providing an effective date.

ASSUMPTIONS:
