DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This bill requires the Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks to appoint a manager and two assistants for the Sun River Game Preserve, and the Sun River, Ear Mountain and Blackleaf Wildlife Management areas.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. The Department of Fish, Wildlife and Parks already has a manager and one assistant responsible for these areas. The department would have to hire one more assistant to comply with this bill.
- 2. We assume the intent of this bill is to have the manager and assistants live on the areas identified.

The proposed expenditures reflect the additional cost for one Wildlife Management Assistant.
