9 Section 1. Section 33-17-505, MCA, is amended to read:

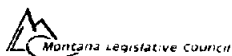
10 "33-17-505. Qualification -- fee. (1) In order to
11 determine the competency of every applicant for license as
12 an insurance consultant, the commissioner shall require

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 33-17-505, MCA, is amended to read:

"33-17-505. Qualification -- fee. (1) In order to determine the competency of every applicant for license as an insurance consultant, the commissioner shall require membership--in--one--or--more--of--the--following--the--American college--of--life--underwriters--the--American--college--of property---and---liability---underwriters---the--society--of actuaries--the--casualty--actuarial--society--or---the--American academy--of--actuaries--or require the applicant to pass an examination.

(2) The fee for taking such an examination shall be \$50. The commissioner shall deposit all fees collected in the general fund. The fee for taking a second or subsequent examination shall be no more than the cost of administering such examination, not to exceed \$50."
