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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 61-10-205, MCA, is amended to read:

"61-10-205. Special fees -- haulers of ready-mix concrete -- dump trucks. There shall be paid and collected annually a fee equal to 55% of the fees provided in Schedule II and Schedule II, as provided in 61-10-201 and 61-10-202, on:

- (1) concrete mixer trucks, concrete mixer trailers, and concrete mixer semitrailers used exclusively for hauling ready-mix or ready-to-pour concrete and truck tractors used exclusively in hauling concrete mixer semitrailers; and
- (2) single-unit dump trucks under 54,750 pounds gross vehicle weight."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the department of highways to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this act.
