8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Section 7-6-2116, MCA, is amended to read:

10 "7-6-2116. Receipt for money paid to county treasurer.

11 When (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), when any
 12 money is paid to the county treasurer, he must issue a
 13 receipt, in triplicate, for such money, the original of
 14 which shall be delivered to the person paying the same, the
 15 duplicate of which shall be delivered to the county clerk,
 16 and the triplicate shall be retained in his office.

 18 (2) When any money is paid to the county treasurer
 19 through the mail or by any electronic means, he must issue
 20 receipts for the money. The original receipt shall be
 21 retained in his office and a duplicate shall be delivered to
 22 the county clerk. The county treasurer may also issue a
 23 receipt to the person paying the money."

24 Section 2. Section 15-16-104, MCA, is amended to read:

25 "15-16-104. Entry of payment -- receipt. (1) The

1 county treasurer must note the date and the amount of the
 2 payment of any tax in the assessment book opposite the name
 3 of the person paying.

4 (2) (a) He Except as provided in subsection (2)(b), he
 5 must give a receipt to the person paying any tax, specifying
 6 the amount of the assessment and the tax paid, with a
