(2) The department shall reserve for applicants who are permanently physically handicapped and nonambulatory, as determined by the department, up to 25 of the total special antelope licenses authorized for sale in the state, for use in the district designated by the applicant COMMISSION. IF

THE NUMBER OF VALID DISABLED APPLICANTS EXCEEDS THE NUMBER OF LICENSES AVAILABLE, THE DEPARTMENT MAY HOLD A DRAWING WHEREBY ALL APPLICANTS HAVE AN EQUAL CHANCE OF BEING SELECTED.

(3) The department shall have the authority to may promulgate such rules and regulations as are necessary to implement this section."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the department of fish, wildlife, and parks to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this act.

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. This act is effective March 1, 1988.
