- (2) No Except as provided in subsection (3), no sale or delivery of liquor shall may be made on or from the premises of any state liquor store nor shall may any store be open for the sale of liquor:
 - (a) on any holiday recognized by state law;
- (b) during such other period and on such other days as

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB559, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act allowing agency liquor stores to operate on Sundays, Mondays, and legal holidays; amending section 16-2-104, MCA; and providing an immediate effective date.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed law would allow agency liquor stores more flexibility to respond to the needs of customers. Its fiscal impact can not be accurately estimated. This proposal may, however cause an increase in liquor sales and related revenue. The increase in sales and revenue would become more and more significant as state liquor stores are converted to agency stores. This proposal would have no impact on Department of Revenue expenditures.
