 3 chapters 1 through 6, and the provisions of Title 16,
 4 chapters 1 through 6, apply to section 1.

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Resident representatives required. (1) For
 12 the purposes of this section, "vendor" means a person,
 13 partnership, association, or corporation that sells liquor
 14 to the department.

15 (2) A vendor who desires to promote the sale of his
 16 product in the state shall employ one representative and may
 17 employ an additional representative to promote the sale of
 18 the vendor's product. A representative must be or become
 19 after employment a resident of the state. If a vacancy
 20 occurs in a representative position, the vendor shall fill
 21 the position within 60 days after the vacancy occurs.

22 Section 2. Extension of authority. Any existing
 23 authority of the department of revenue to make rules on the
 24 subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the
 25 provisions of this act.
