BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Broadcast of floor sessions allowed. (1) A radio station may broadcast any committee of the whole proceeding of legislative sessions.

(2) A radio station using the network system for broadcast shall pay for the use of the microwave network feed and terminating equipment according to the rate established by the department of administration.

Section 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the state general fund to the telecommunications bureau of the department of administration \$15,000 to purchase terminating equipment at both ends of the microwave network circuits. Money not used to purchase terminating equipment must revert to the state general fund.

Section 3. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the department of administration and the legislature to make rules on the subject of the provisions
