In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB611, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act allocating reimbursements for indirect costs of university grants and contracts to the University System.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. 15% of all indirect cost recoveries are currently deposited in the designated fund; 85% are appropriated for general operating costs of the university units.
2. All indirect costs recoveries of each university system unit would be deposited in a designated fund for use by the unit.
3. General fund money would replace the indirect cost revenue that is currently appropriated for general operating costs of the units.

 14 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

15       Section 1. Allocation of indirect cost reimbursements.  
 16 Any FIFTY PERCENT OF ANY reimbursement for indirect costs  
 17 associated with a grant to or contract with the Montana  
 18 university system or any of its units is allocated to the  
 19 designated subfund of the university current fund, as  
 20 provided in 17-2-102, for distribution to the unit receiving  
 21 the grant or under the contract. SEVEN AND ONE-HALF PERCENT  
 22 OF THE FUNDS ALLOCATED TO THE DESIGNATED SUBFUND UNDER THIS  
 23 SECTION SHALL BE REALLOCATED BY THE MONTANA BOARD OF REGENTS  
 24 OF HIGHER EDUCATION TO MONTANA COLLEGE OF MINERAL SCIENCE  
 25 AND TECHNOLOGY, EASTERN MONTANA COLLEGE, NORTHERN MONTANA

1   COLLEGE, AND WESTERN MONTANA COLLEGE.

2           Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is  
 3 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 20,  
 4 chapter 25, part 4, and the provisions of Title 20, chapter  
 5 25, part 4, apply to section 1.

6           Section 3. Effective date. This act is effective July  
 7 1, 1987.
