4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT DEFINING MOTORBIKE;
5 PROHIBITING THE USE OF MOTORBIKES WITHIN ONE MILE OF THE
6 CITY LIMITS OF AN INCORPORATED CITY OR TOWN; AND PROVIDING
7 AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Motorbike defined. "Motorbike" means an
11 unlicensed two- or three-wheeled motorcycle or motor-driven
12 cycle designed for traveling off developed roadways and
13 highways. The term includes a trail bike, dirt bike, enduro
14 bike, motocross bike, or any dual purpose motorcycle.

15 Section 2. Prohibited operation of motorbikes within
16 city limits. No person may operate a motorbike, as defined
17 in [section 1], within 1 mile of the city limits of an
18 incorporated city or town.

19 Section 3. Extension of authority. Any existing
20 authority of the department of justice to make rules on the
21 subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the
22 provisions of this act.

23 Section 4. Codification instructions. (1) Section 1 is
24 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 61,
25 chapter 1, part 1, and the provisions of Title 61, chapter

1 1, part 1, apply to section 1.

2 (2) Section 2 is intended to be codified as an
3 integral part of Title 61, chapter 8, part 3, and the
4 provisions of Title 61, chapter 8, part 3, apply to section
5 2.

6 Section 5. Effective date. This act is effective on
7 passage and approval.
