BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Motorbike defined. "Motorbike" means an unlicensed two- or three-wheeled motorcycle or motor-driven cycle designed for traveling off developed roadways and highways. The term includes a trail bike, dirt bike, enduro bike, motocross bike, or any dual purpose motorcycle.

15 Section 2. Prohibited operation of motorbikes within 16 city limits. No person may operate a motorbike, as defined 17 in [section 1], within 1 mile of the city limits of an 18 incorporated city or town.

Section 3. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the department of justice to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this act.

23 Section 4. Codification instructions. (1) Section 1 is 24 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 61, 25 chapter 1, part 1, and the provisions of Title 61, chapter
