- (1) concrete mixer trucks, concrete mixer trailers, and concrete mixer semitrailers used exclusively for hauling ready-mix or ready-to-pour concrete and truck tractors used exclusively in hauling concrete mixer semitrailers; and
- (2) fertilizer tender trucks and tender trailers and fertilizer spreader trucks and spreader trailers used exclusively to transport or to apply fertilizer to agricultural fields and plots. The applicant for a special fee under this subsection shall show, when the fee is paid as provided in 61-10-222, a valid fertilizer dealer license

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB656, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act including fertilizer haulers among those eligible to pay gross vehicle weight fees of 55% of schedules; and providing a delayed effective date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Fertilizer tender trucks, tender trailers, spreader trucks and spreader trailers would qualify for 55% G.V.W. fees.
- 2. The trucks and trailers are currently paying 100% G.V.W. fees.
- 3. 250 trucks will be affected 85 tender trucks and 165 spreader trucks.
- 4. Tender trucks will license at an average of 46,000 pounds G.V.W. and spreader trucks at 28,000 pounds G.V.W..
- 5. 1,500 trailers will be affected. Trailers will license at an average 14,000 pounds G.V.W..
- 6. The proposal fully impacts FY88.
