A statement of intent is required for this bill in order to clarify that the board of natural resources and conservation and boards of supervisors of conservation districts may revise their rules as necessary. Section 2 clarifies that boards of supervisors are authorized to establish standards and guidelines for projects and exclusions within their districts for matters not covered by the minimum standards and guidelines established by the board of natural resources and conservation. Section 2 also provides authorization to adopt rules identifying repair and maintenance activities that are not "projects", as that term is defined in 75-7-103, because the activities do not significantly alter a stream. Section 2 further authorizes rulemaking to identify the following:

- (1) categories of information that should be included in plans of annual operation;
  - (2) procedures for filing the plans; and
- (3) procedures for evaluation and board of supervisordecisions concerning the plans.
