BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT APPROPRIATING \$200,000

Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the stripper well payment contained in the federal special revenue account to the superintendent of public instruction \$200,000 for fiscal year 1988, to be used for grants to school districts for energy conservation in new elementary schools.

Section 2. Eligibility. A school district may apply at any time after the effective date of this act to the superintendent of public instruction for a grant to finance energy conservation in a new elementary school. The superintendent of public instruction shall award grants, to the extent that funds are available, to school districts that:

24 (1) propose methods of energy conservation that can 25 reasonably be expected to reduce energy costs significantly



- in an elementary school that is under construction on the
- 2 effective date of this act or that will be under
- 3 construction before September 1, 1987, and will be completed
- before September 1, 1988; and
- 5 (2) demonstrate that no other adequate source of funds
- 6 is available for this purpose.
