4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT APPROPRIATING \$200,000  
5 TO THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION FROM THE  
6 STRIPPER WELL PAYMENT CONTAINED IN THE FEDERAL SPECIAL  
7 REVENUE ACCOUNT, FOR ENERGY CONSERVATION ASSISTANCE TO NEW  
8 SCHOOLS."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from  
12 the stripper well payment contained in the federal special  
13 revenue account to the superintendent of public instruction  
14 \$200,000 for fiscal year 1988, to be used for grants to  
15 school districts for energy conservation in new elementary  
16 schools.

17 Section 2. Eligibility. A school district may apply at  
18 any time after the effective date of this act to the  
19 superintendent of public instruction for a grant to finance  
20 energy conservation in a new elementary school. The  
21 superintendent of public instruction shall award grants, to  
22 the extent that funds are available, to school districts  
23 that:

24 (1) propose methods of energy conservation that can  
25 reasonably be expected to reduce energy costs significantly

1 in an elementary school that is under construction on the  
2 effective date of this act or that will be under  
3 construction before September 1, 1987, and will be completed  
4 before September 1, 1988; and  
5 (2) demonstrate that no other adequate source of funds  
6 is available for this purpose.
