There is appropriated to the 13 department of social and rehabilitation services \$5 million 14 from the Exxon corporation overcharge payment contained in 15 the federal special revenue account for the biennium ending 16 June 30, 1987, for use in the low-income home weatherization 17 program provided for in 90-4-201.

18 Section 2. Preferential hiring of general assistance 19 recipients for low-income home weatherization projects. The 20 department of social and rehabilitation services shall 21 encourage human resource development councils and other 22 public or nonprofit entities that receive weatherization funds to hire individuals who are eligible for general 23 24 relief under Title 53, chapter 3, to work in home 25 weatherization projects, to the maximum extent possible.



Section 3. Extension of authority. Any existing
authority of the department of social and rehabilitation
services to make rules on the subject of the provisions of
this act is extended to the provisions of this act.
