At least one person appointed by each legislative leader must be a current legislator serving in 20 21 the same house and of the same political party, and at least 22 one person must be a person not currently serving in the 23 legislature.

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3 Section 2. Meetings. (1) The chairman shall schedule 4 meetings of the commission as considered necessary, but 5 meetings must be held at least bimonthly. Section 3. Reimbursement of expenses. Members of the commission must be reimbursed in accordance with 2-18-501 for actual and necessary expenses incurred in attending meetings or conducting business.

Section 4. Staff and facilities. (1) The commission shall appoint a director and fix his salary and compensation. The director, subject to the approval of the commission, shall hire the necessary staff and fix their compensation, and he may contract with consultants as needed.
