The judge shall 15 16 determine the prevailing party for purposes of this section. 17 Section 2. Codification instruction. Section 1 is 18 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 25, chapter 10, part 3, and the provisions of Title 25, chapter 19 10, part 3, apply to section 1. 20
