A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING A HOSPITAL TO NOTIFY A PATIENT, PRIOR TO RELEASE, THAT HE IS NOT REQUIRED TO PURCHASE PRESCRIBED MEDICATION FROM A PHARMACY LOCATED IN THE HOSPITAL."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Hospital pharmacy -- notice to patient. A hospital, as defined in 50-5-101, shall, prior to release of a patient for whom medication has been prescribed, notify the patient that he is not required to purchase the prescribed medication from the pharmacy located in the hospital. The notice required by this section may be given either by means of an oral or a written statement to the patient being released.
