The department of fish, wildlife, and parks shall have jurisdiction, custody, and control of the center and museum, but shall lease the facility to the city of Fort Benton for so long as the city of Fort Benton provides for development, operation, and maintenance of the center and museum without cost to the state of Montana.

Section 2. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the department of fish, wildlife, and parks to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this act.

23 Section 3. Codification instruction. Section 1 is 24 intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 23, 25 chapter 1, part 1, and the provisions of Title 23, chapter 1 1, part 1, apply to section 1.
