(1) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the board shall authorize the 13 14 department to issue to a qualified applicant a temporary license to practice medicine if the applicant is employed at 15 the Montana state hospital or any other state-owned health 16 17 care facility and meets the qualifications for licensure under 37-3-305(3), except the number of temporary licenses 18 19 issued may not exceed four in any one calendar year.

(2) A qualified applicant for a temporary license
under subsection (1) may not be required to meet any
additional qualifications for licensure. However, the board
may authorize the department to issue the temporary license
subject to terms of probation and other conditions or
limitations set by the board or may refuse to approve a

1 temporary license if the applicant has committed 2 unprofessional conduct or is otherwise unqualified.

3 Section 2. Extension of authority. Any existing
4 authority of the board of medical examiners to make rules on
5 the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the
