A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT LIMITING THE NUMBER OF BINGO OR KENO MACHINES IN AN ESTABLISHMENT; PROVIDING FOR HOURS OF PLAY OF BINGO OR KENO AND VIDEO DRAW POKER MACBINES: AMENDING SECTIONS 23-5-402, ANE 23-5-414, AND 23-5-603, MCA; AND PROVIDING AR--モMMEBIATE EFFECTIVE BAPE DATES AND A TERMINATION DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
Section 1. Section 23-5-402, MCA, is amended to read:
"23-5-402. Definitions. As used in this part, unless the context requires otherwise, the following terms or phrases shall have the following meanings:
(1) "Bingo OR KENO machine" means an electronic video game machine that, upon insertion of cash, is available to play or simulate the play of the game of bingo OR KENO, utilizing a video display and microprocessors, in which by the skill of the player or by chance, or both, the player may receive free games or credits that can be redeemed for cash. The term does not include a machine that directly dispenses coins, cash, tokens, or anything else of value.
$t+t(2)$ "Game of chance" means the specific kind of
game of chance commonly known as:
(a) "bingo" OR "KENO", in which prizes are awarded on the basis of designated numbers or symbols on a card which conform to numbers or symbols selected at random;
(b) "raffles", which are conducted by drawing for prizes.
$+z+(3)$ "Equipment" means:
(a) with respect to bingo OR KENO, the receptacle and numbered objects drawn from it, the master board upon which such objects are placed as drawn, the cards or sheets bearing numbers or other designations to be covered and the objects used to cover them, the boards or signs, however operated, used to announce or display the numbers or designations as they are drawn, public address system, and all other articles essential to the operation, conduct, and playing of bingo OR KENO; or
(b) with respect to raffles, the implements, devices, and machines designed, intended, or used for the conduct of raffles and the identification of the winning number or unit and the ticket or other evidence of right to participate in raffles."

SECTION 2. SECTION 23-5-414, MCA, IS AMENDED TO READ:
"23-5-414. Restrictions on bingo, keno, and raffles =bingo or keno machines in establishment limit -- exception - hours of operation. (1) In the playing of bingo or keno,
no person who is not physically present on the premises where the game is actually conducted shall be allowed to participate as a player in the game
（2）Raffles authorized by this part shall be restricted to events and participants within the geographic confines of the state of Montana．
（3）No establishment may receive licenses for，under 23－5－421，or make available for play more than 40 bingo or keno machines．＂

Section 3．Section 23－5－414，MCA，is amended to read：
＂23－5－414．Restrictions on bingo，KENO，and raffles－－ bingo OR KENO machines in establishment limit －－hours of operation．（1）In the playing of bingo OR KENO， no person who is not physically present on the premises where the game is actually conducted shall be allowed to participate as a player in the game．
（2）Raffles authorized by this part shall be restricted to events and participants within the geographic confines of the state of Montana．

＂23－5－603．Video draw poker machines－－possession－－ play＝－hours of play－－restriction．（1）No person may place an electronic video game machine that simulates or offers a game of poker in his licensed establishment unless
he is licensed under 23-5-612. Machines licensed under 23-5-612 are legal, and it is legal to play such machines, except that a person under the age of 18 years may not play a video draw poker machine and.
(2) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (3), an establishment that receives a license to make a video draw poker machine available for play must be-ezosed HAVE THE MACHINES SHUT OFF each day during the hours provided in 16-3-304 for closure of licensed retail alcoholic beverage
 GEVERNING-BEDY.
(3) A LOCAL GOVERNING BODY MAY ESTABLISH ANY HOURS OF PLAY FOR VIDEO DRAW POKER MACHINES THAT IT DETERMINES PROPER.
(4) The provisions of part 3 of this chapter do not apply to or prohibit video draw poker machines or the playing of such machines."

NEW SECTION. Section 5. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the department of revenue to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this act.

NEW SECTION. Section 6. Effective date DATES -TERMINATION DATE. This (1) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (2). THIS act is effective on-passage-and-approvat JULY 1 , 1988.
