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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION DIVISION TO PROCESS ALL CURRENT PLAN NO. 3 CLAIMS WITHIN 90 DAYS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT AND TO MAKE INITIAL CONTACT WITH A CLAIMANT WITHIN 5 WORKING DAYS OF RECEIPT OF A CLAIM; PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION; AMENDING SECTION 39-71-604, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."


BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Processing of current workers' compensation claims. (1) Within 90 days of the effective date of this act, the workers' compensation division shall complete the processing of all claims for benefits made under the Workers' Compensation Act plan No. 3 that have been filed and for which the state fund is liable.

(2) The division shall employ sufficient temporary personnel to allow it to implement subsection (1).

Section 2. Section 39-71-604, MCA, is amended to read:

"39-71-604. Application for compensation. (1) Where a
worker is entitled to benefits under this chapter, the
worker shall file with the insurer or the division all
reasonable information needed by the insurer to determine



compensability. It is the duty of the worker's attending physician to lend all necessary assistance in making application for compensation and such proof of other matters as may be required by the rules of the division without charge to the worker. The filing of forms or other documentation by the attending physician does not constitute a claim for compensation.

- 8 (2) Where death results from an injury, the parties
  9 entitled to compensation or someone in their behalf shall
  10 file a claim with the insurer or the division. The claim
  11 must be accompanied with proof of death and proof of
  12 relationship, showing the parties entitled to compensation,
  13 certificate of the attending physician, if any, and such
  14 other proof as may be required by the division.
  - (3) Within 5 working days of receipt of a claim for compensation, the division shall make an initial contact with the worker regarding the claim."

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the state special revenue fund an amount sufficient to implement section 1.

NEW SECTION. Section 4. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the division of workers' compensation to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this act.
