Annual conference on the state of Montana 11 business. (1) The department of commerce shall establish. 12 organize, promote, and conduct an annual conference on the 13 state of Montana business to: 14 (a) assess economic conditions and trends in Montana: 15 (b) evaluate the state of business in Montana; 16 (c) discuss and disseminate new ideas to stimulate and promote business in Montana; and 17 (d) develop potential solutions to the problems of 18 business, industry, and agriculture in Montana. 19 (2) The department shall cooperate with and solicit 20 financial support and participation in the annual conference 21 on the state of Montana business from state and local 22 23 government agencies and from all segments of the Montana economy, including business and industry, agriculture, 24 25 transportation, and labor organizations as well as the units

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of the Montana university system and all other persons and
 entities concerned with the economic future of the state.

3 Section 2. Appropriation -- condition for expenditure.
4 (1) There is appropriated to the department of commerce from
5 the general fund, for the purposes set forth in [section 1]:
6 (a) \$5,000 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1987;

8 (b) \$5,000 for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1988.
9 (2) The money appropriated in subsection (1) may be
10 expended by the department only to match equal amounts
11 contributed by private sources to support the purposes set
12 forth in [section 1].

13 Section 3. Effective date. This act is effective July14 1, 1987.
