5 THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE TO DEVELOP PLANS FOR ONE-STOP
6 BUSINESS LICENSING; REQUIRING A REPORT TO THE 51ST
7 LEGISLATURE; AND PROVIDING A TERMINATION DATE."

9 WHEREAS, reduction of unnecessary cost for any business
10 will benefit directly all residents of this state; and

11 WHEREAS, unification and simplification of the
12 procedures for licensing of business and industry will
13 effect immediate savings in time, effort, and money for
14 business licensees.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

17 Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the
18 department of commerce from the general fund \$5,000 for the
19 biennium beginning July 1, 1987, to be used to develop
20 alternate plans for unified or one-stop administration of
21 laws providing licensing of business and industry including:

22 (1) a plan that reorganizes and combines existing
23 functions of departments of state government within a single
24 designated agency and creates a master business license
25 program; and

1 (2) a plan that continues the existing functions
2 within the current structure of departments of state
3 government.

4 Section 2. Report to 51st legislature. The department
5 shall present to the 51st legislature:

6 (1) the alternate plans prepared under [section 1];
7 and

8 (2) the estimated cost of implementing each plan
9 prepared under [section 1].

10 Section 3. Termination. This act terminates June 30,
11 1989.
