4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT APPROPRIATING MONEY TO
5 THE DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE FOR MATCHING EXPENDITURES BY THE
6 MONTANA AMBASSADORS FOR NEW BUSINESS RECRUITMENT; AND
7 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND A TERMINATION DATE."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from
11 the general fund to the department of commerce \$20,000 for
12 the biennium beginning July 1, 1987, for the purposes
13 provided in section 2.

14 Section 2. Business recruitment project. The
15 department of commerce shall use the money appropriated in
16 [section 1] to match equally expenditures by the Montana
17 ambassadors:

18 (1) for lawful services or inducements in the
19 recruitment of new industry to locate in Montana; or

20 (2) to pay the costs of protocol incurred during the
21 recruitment of new business or new industry.

22 Section 3. Reports to committee. The director of the
23 department of commerce shall inform the legislative audit
24 committee on the first day of each October, January, April,
25 and July of the amount of each individual expenditure and

1 the total expenditures under this act during the immediately
2 preceding 3 months, the total amount of matching
3 expenditures by the ambassadors during the same period, the
4 purpose of the expenditures, the names of the recipients,
5 and the dates and places of any inducements or services.

6 Section 4. Exception to expense limits. For the
7 purposes of this act, the provisions of 2-18-501(1)(b) and
8 (2)(b) do not apply insofar as those provisions limit the
9 ability of the department of commerce to provide services
10 and facilities comparable to those furnished in the private
11 sector that are necessary to accomplish the purposes of this
12 act.

13 Section 5. Effective date -- termination. This act is
14 effective July 1, 1987, and terminates June 30, 1989, except
15 that the director of the department of commerce is required
16 to make the report to the legislative audit committee
17 required by section 3 on July 1, 1989.

A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT APPROPRIATING--MONEY--TO

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

~~Section 1. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the general fund to the department of commerce \$20,000 for the biennium beginning July 1, 1987, for the purposes provided in section 2.~~

Section 1. Business recruitment project. The department of commerce shall use the money appropriated in HOUSE BILL NO. 862 {~~section 1~~} to match equally EQUAL expenditures by the Montana ambassadors:

(1) for lawful services or inducements in the recruitment of new industry to locate in Montana; or

(2) to pay the costs of protocol incurred during the

recruitment of new business or new industry.

Section 2. Reports to committee. The director of the department of commerce shall inform the legislative audit committee on the first day of each October, January, April, and July of the amount of each individual expenditure and the total expenditures under this act during the immediately preceding 3 months, the total amount of matching expenditures by the ambassadors during the same period, the purpose of the expenditures, the names of the recipients, and the dates and places of any inducements or services.

Section 3. Exception to expense limits. For the purposes of this act, the provisions of 2-18-501(1)(b) and (2)(b) do not apply insofar as those provisions limit the ability of the department of commerce to provide services and facilities comparable to those furnished in the private sector that are necessary to accomplish the purposes of this act.

Section 4. Effective date -- termination. This act is effective July 1, 1987, and terminates June 30, 1989, except that the director of the department of commerce is required to make the report to the legislative audit committee required by section 3 2 on July 1, 1989.
