8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Appropriation. All revenues received under
10 the provisions of 20-9-343 for state equalization aid are
11 appropriated to the superintendent of public instruction for
12 the biennium ending June 30, 1989, for public school support
13 other than special education.

14 Section 2. Contingent appropriation. There is
15 appropriated from the general fund \$77,101,000 for the
16 biennium ending June 30, 1989, to be used to the extent
17 funds appropriated in section 1 are insufficient to finance
18 the maximum general fund budget schedules for public
19 schools, excluding special education.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

9 Section 1. Appropriation. All revenues received under
10 the provisions of 20-9-343 for state equalization aid are
11 appropriated to the superintendent of public instruction for
12 the biennium ending June 30, 1989, for public school support
13 other than special education.

14 Section 2. Contingent appropriation. There is
15 appropriated from the general fund ~~\$77,101,000~~ \$96,000,000
16 for the biennium ending June 30, 1989, to be used to the
17 extent funds appropriated in section 1 are insufficient to
18 finance the maximum general fund budget schedules for public
19 schools, excluding special education.
