DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

Requiring the Board of Public Education to prescribe a salary schedule for the professional faculty and staff of the School for the Deaf and Blind that is equal to the salary level for the teachers and staff of the largest school district in Cascade county.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. As the bill has an immediate effective date, assume it is approved on April 15, 1987.
2. For purposes of this note, assume that the Great Falls school district teacher salary schedule is frozen at the 1987 level through FY89.
