House JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 7 1 INTRODUCED BY Car Taccom the 2 3 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE 4 OF 5 REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA RECOMMENDING б PRIORITY OF FISCAL MATTERS BEFORE THE LEGISLATURE. 7 8 WHEREAS, the Montana Constitution charges the Legislature with appropriating Montana's funds, establishing 9 10 Montana's revenue, and causing the State of Montana to 11 operate within a balanced budget; and WHEREAS, proper resolution of fiscal matters is of 12 13 utmost concern to the Legislature and to the people of the 14 state; and 15 WHEREAS, nonfiscal matters compete with fiscal matters for the attention of the Legislature; and 16 17 WHEREAS, the Legislature desires to properly execute its duties to the people of the state and their 18 19 Constitution. 20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE 21 22 OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 23 That appropriation, taxation, and budgetary matters 24 have first priority before committees of the Montana Legislature; and 25

That appropriation, taxation, and budgetary matters
have first priority with legislative staff, including the
Legislative Council staff; and

4 That the Governor is hereby requested to give first 5 priority and cooperation, and the priority and cooperation 6 of the Executive Branch, to the early resolution of such 7 fiscal matters; and

8 That the House and the Senate shall adjust, adopt, or 9 suspend rules to move any such fiscal matters to the top of 10 each day's agenda, and shall develop and use such other 11 procedures as needed to assist in accomplishing the intent 12 of this resolution; and

13 That the House Committee on Appropriations and the 14 Senate Committee on Finance and Claims are instructed to 15 review all earmarked revenue budgets and to submit the 16 results of their reviews to their respective chambers, 17 indicating whether funds earmarked in those budgets may be 18 transferred to the general fund and, if not, precisely the 19 reason or reasons why not.

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
