4 A JOINT RESOLUTION OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA TO EXPRESS SUPPORT

5 FOR THE SITING OF THE MIDGETMAN MISSILE SYSTEM WITHIN

6 MONTANA SHOULD THE FEDERAL ADMINISTRATION AND THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS DETERMINE THAT DEVELOPMENT AND DEPLOYMENT OF

7 THE MIDGETMAN MISSILE SYSTEM IS IN THE NATIONAL INTEREST.

8 WHEREAS the federal Administration and the United States Congress will determine whether the Midgetman missile

9 system is needed to meet the long-term defense requirements of the nation; and

10 WHEREAS, the State of Montana is proud that its citizens have patriotically rallied to defend freedom and

11 democracy in every war since 1889 in numbers far greater per capita than those of other states; and

12 WHEREAS, the Montana Legislature recognizes that the federal government is mandated by the United States

13 Constitution to provide for a common defense that is critical to ensure world peace and maintain democratic

14 ideals; and

15 WHEREAS, the state is proud that deployment of the first Minuteman missiles in Montana more than 25 years ago

16 provided President Kennedy with negotiating strength necessary to peacefully resolve the Cuban missile crisis; and

17 WHEREAS, the state is now home to and proudly supports the men and women of the 341st Strategic Missile Wing, the nation's finest Strategic Missile Wing.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

19 (1) That if the federal Administration and the United States Congress conclude that deployment of the Midgetman missile system is in the national interest and select the State of Montana as the optimal deployment site, the Legislature will cooperate fully with the United States Government and the Department of Defense.

20 (2) That copies of this resolution be sent to the Secretary of Defense, Secretary of the Air Force, Chief of Staff of the United States Air Force, and the Commander of the Strategic Air Command.
