In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HJR030, as introduced.

### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSET LEGISLATION:

A joint resolution of the Senate and House of Representatives of the State of Montana consenting to the construction of a water system at the University of Montana.

#### **ASSUMPTIONS:**

The joint resolution is an act of consent and doesn't appropriate any money to the University of Montana. However, by passage, the University of Montana will be able to spend money for the construction of a water system.

# FISCAL IMPACT:

This joint resolution does not of itself carry any fiscal impact, but its authorization allows the University of Montana to spend \$335,000 for the construction of a water system with non-general fund money. Pay-back is anticipated from cost savings within five years.

#### EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUE OR EXPENDITURES:

The water system will make the University of Montana independent as to city water use and cost. The cost savings to the University of Montana is anticipated to be \$76,000 annually.
