3 (2) the potential for, and desirability of,
 4 construction and operation of visitor information centers in
 5 Montana;

6 (3) methods for increasing international visitation to
 7 Montana;

8 (4) methods for enhancing Montana's scheduled and
 9 charter air service;

10 (5) current incentives for private development of
 11 tourism destinations and facilities; and

12 (6) incentives or disincentives for development
 13 financing in the tourism sector.

14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the committee report the
 15 findings of the study to the 51st Legislature and, if
 16 necessary, draft legislation to implement its
 17 recommendations.
