A RESOLUTION OF THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA AMENDING HOUSE RULE 3-2 TO REQUIRE THAT AT LEAST ONE REPRESENTATIVE FROM EACH COUNTY HAVING A POPULATION GREATER THAN 30,000 BE APPOINTED TO THE HOUSE APPROPRIATIONS COMMITTEE; AND PROVIDING AN APPLICABILITY DATE.

WHEREAS, Cascade, Flathead, Gallatin, Lewis and Clark, Missoula, Silver Bow, and Yellowstone Counties contain the greatest proportion of Montana's population; and

WHEREAS, these counties require the greatest expenditure of funds for state services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

(1) That House Rule 3-2 be amended to read:

"H3-2. The Committee on Rules shall consist of the Speaker, the majority leader and other members of the majority party appointed by the Speaker, and the minority leader and other members of the minority party designated by the minority leader and appointed by the Speaker. The Speaker shall appoint the members of other standing committees, select committees, and house membership on joint

committees and conference committees. The House Appropriations Committee is required to have at least one representative from each county having a population greater than 30,000.

(2) That this resolution apply to the proceedings of the 50th Legislature."
