1 (6) For the purposes of this section, "refueling
2 service" means the pumping of motor vehicle fuel into the
3 tank of a motor vehicle.

4 Section 2. Section 49-4-306, MCA, is amended to read:
5 "49-4-306. Department of justice to publicize permit
6 and refueling service requirement. (1) The department of
7 justice shall publicize the provisions of 49-4-301 through
8 49-4-305 and of [sections 1 through 4] in a manner designed
9 to inform those eligible for a special parking permit.

10 (2) The department of justice shall budget sufficient
11 funds to accomplish the requirements of subsection (1)."

12 Section 3. Section 49-4-307, MCA, is amended to read:
13 "49-4-307. Penalty. A person who parks a motor vehicle
14 in violation of 49-4-302(2) or who refuses to provide, upon
15 request, refueling service as required in [section 1] is
16 guilty of a misdemeanor and is punishable by a fine of not
17 less than \$10 or more than \$100."

18 Section 4. Section 61-3-454, MCA, is amended to read:
19 "61-3-454. Special parking privilege -- refueling
20 service. A vehicle lawfully displaying specially inscribed
21 license plates issued under 61-3-451 and conveying a 100%
22 disabled veteran is entitled to the parking privileges
23 allowed a handicapped person's vehicle under 49-4-302 and,
24 whenever the 100% disabled veteran is unaccompanied by a
25 physically able person, the refueling service required under

1 [section 1]."

2 NEW SECTION. Section 5. Extension of authority. Any
3 existing authority of the department of justice and the
4 department of revenue to make rules on the subject of the
5 provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this
6 act.

7 NEW SECTION. Section 6. Codification instruction.
8 Section 1 is intended to be codified as an integral part of
9 Title 49, chapter 4, part 3, and the provisions of Title 49,
10 chapter 4, part 3, apply to section 1.
