4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOWING THE GOVERNOR
5 TO ORDER RENEGOTIATION OF WAGE AND BENEFIT PROVISIONS IN
6 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENTS COVERING STATE EMPLOYEES IF
7 PROJECTED REVENUE WILL NOT FUND TOTAL STATE GOVERNMENT
8 APPROPRIATIONS; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

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10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 Section 1. Nonnegotiable item for public employees of
12 the state. Collective bargaining agreements covering public
13 employees of the state of Montana, including the university
14 system, entered into after [the effective date of this act]
15 must contain a provision requiring renegotiation of wages
16 and benefits subject to an order of the governor under
17 [section 2].

18 Section 2. Renegotiation on order of governor. If the
19 budget director appointed under 17-7-103 projects a
20 shortfall of 3% or more in the revenue necessary to fund the
21 total state government appropriations as passed by the
22 legislature for a fiscal year or fiscal biennium, the
23 governor may order renegotiation of the wage and benefit
24 provisions of any or all collective bargaining agreements
25 that cover public employees of the state of Montana,

1 including the university system, during that fiscal year or
2 fiscal biennium.

3 Section 3. Extension of authority. Any existing
4 authority of the board of personnel appeals to make rules on
5 the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the
6 provisions of this act.

7 Section 4. Codification instruction. Sections 1 and 2
8 are intended to be codified as an integral part of Title 39,
9 chapter 31, and the provisions of Title 39, chapter 31,
10 apply to sections 1 and 2.

11 Section 5. Effective date. This act is effective on
12 passage and approval.

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
