5 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PERMIT COMMERCIAL

FISHING OF THE GAME FISH CISCO; AND AMENDING SECTIONS 87-3-204, 87-4-601, AND 87-4-605, MCA."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 87-3-204, MCA, is amended to read:

"87-3-204. Restrictions on fishing methods. (1) No game fish may be caught, captured, or taken or attempted to be caught, captured, or taken by the aid or with the use of any gun or trap, nor may any such set gun, trap, or other device to entrap game fish be used, made, or set.

- (2) It is unlawful for a person to take or catch fish in any of the waters of this state, except with hook and line held in hand or line and hook attached to rod or pole held in hand; to take or catch fish with hook baited with any poisonous substance or by means of the use of any poisonous substance, including fish berries; or to take or catch fish by means of the use of fishtraps, grabhooks, seines, nets, or other similar means for catching fish.
- 24 (3) The department may designate such waters within
 25 the state of Montana wherein, in the judgment of the

department, spears or gigs may be used for taking walleyed pike, sauger, northern pike, and nongame fish and traps, seines, nets, and rubber or spring-propelled spears, when employed by sportsmen swimming or submerged in the water, may be used for the taking of designated species of fish. The waters so designated may be closed at the discretion of the department. The taking of all fish by such means in the waters, when so designated, is to be done under such rules as the department may prescribe with reference thereto and 9 under the supervision of the department. All such nongame 10 fish so taken may be possessed and sold in such manner and 11 under such restrictions as the department may direct. All 12 fish, other than those herein designated, so taken under 13 department rules, when prescribed by the department, shall 14 be returned uninjured to the waters from which they were 15 16 taken.

- 17 (4) The taking of black bass in Flathead Lake may be permitted by the department.
 - (5) The department shall have the power to designate certain waters where setlines may be used to fish for certain species of game or nongame fish, and the department may designate the number of hooks and lines and the length of line or lines which may be used as setlines.
 - (6) Game fish shall be taken only by angling; that is, by hook and single line in hand or single rod in hand or

- . within immediate control. This does not prevent, however:
- 2 (a) the snagging of paddlefish, coho (silver salmon),
 3 and kokanee (sockeye salmon) when the department declares an
 4 open season when paddlefish, coho (silver salmon), and

- 6 (b) the taking of paddlefish with longbow and arrow

- 21 (f) the taking of whitefish by nets or traps in the 22 Kootenai River and in its tributary streams within 1 mile of 23 the Kootenai River, under such rules and regulations as the 24 fish and game commission may prescribe; or
- 25 (g) the taking of cisco by nets, traps, or seines

- 2 Section 2. Section 87-4-601, MCA, is amended to read
 - "87-4-601. Sale of fish or spawn unlawful -
- 4 exceptions. (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), nc
- 5 person may, for speculative purposes, for market, or for
- 6 sale, in any way, catch any of the fish which in this title
- are classified as game fish or remove or cause to be removed
- 8 the eggs or spawn of any such fish. No person may sell or
- 9 offer for sale any of the game fish of this state as defined
- in this title or the eggs or spawn therefrom.
- 11 (2) The restrictions of subsection (1) do not apply
- 12 to:

- 13 (a) the catching of fish in private ponds by the
- owners thereof;
- (b) the taking of fish by state authorities for the

Section 3. Section 87-4-605, MCA, is amended to read:

"87-4-605. Records and report of whitefish and cisco
sales by fishing license holders. A holder of a fishing
license who catches whitefish or cisco for speculative
purposes, for market, or for sale shall keep a record and
make an annual report to the department of the number of
whitefish sold and the date of each sale. The annual report
shall be submitted to the appropriate department regional
office within 15 days of the end of the license year."

NEW SECTION. Section 4. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the fish and game commission to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this act.
