A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING STAFF OF THE DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE TO INQUIRE ORALLY WHETHER AN APPLICANT FOR A DRIVER'S LICENSE OR A RENEWAL INTENDS TO MAKE AN ANATOMICAL GIFT; AMENDING SECTION 61-5-301, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 61-5-301, MCA, is amended to read:

"61-5-301. Indication on driver's license of intent to make anatomical gift. (1) The department of justice shall provide on each operator's or chauffeur's license a space for indicating when the licensee has executed a document under 72-17-204 of intent to make a gift of all or part of his body under the Uniform Anatomical Gift Act.

(2) The department shall provide each applicant, at the time of application for a new driver's license or for a renewal, printed information calling the applicant's attention to the provisions of this section ~~and each~~. Each applicant must be asked orally whether he wishes to make an anatomical gift.

(3) Each applicant must be given an opportunity to indicate in the space provided under subsection (1) his

intent to make an anatomical gift.

~~(3)~~(4) The department shall issue to every applicant who indicates such an intent a statement which, when signed by the licensee in the manner prescribed in 72-17-204, constitutes a document of anatomical gift. This statement must be printed on a sticker that the donor may attach permanently to the back of his driver's license.

~~(4)~~(5) The department shall also furnish the licensee a means of revoking the document of gift upon the license."

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any existing authority of the department of justice to make rules on the subject of the provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this act.

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Effective date. This act is effective on passage and approval.
