1 INTRODUCED BY

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A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO ESTABLISH ADDITIONAL PENALTIES FOR INDIVIDUALS CONVICTED FOR TWO MORE INCIDENTS OF ELDER ABUSE, NEGLECT, OR EXPLOITATION; AND AMENDING SECTION 53-5-525, MCA."

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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 Section 1. Section 53-5-525, MCA, is amended to read: 11 "53-5-525. Penalties. (1) Any person who purposely or 12 knowingly fails to make a report required by 53-5-511 or discloses or fails to disclose the contents of a case record 13 14 or report in violation of 53-5-513 is guilty of a misdemeanor an offense and upon conviction is punishable as 15 16 provided in 46-18-212.

- (2) Any individual who purposely or knowingly abuses, neglects, or exploits an older person is guilty of a misdemeanor an offense and upon conviction:
- 20 (a) of a first offense may be fined an amount not to 21 exceed \$500 or be imprisoned in the county jail for a term not to exceed 6 months, or both; and 22
- 23 (b) of a second or succeeding offense shall be fined 24 not less than \$1,000 or be imprisoned in the state prison 25 for a term not less than 1 year, or both."



NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any 1 existing authority of the department of social 2 rehabilitation services to make rules on the subject of the 3 provisions of this act is extended to the provisions of this act.

### STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE

#### Form BD-15

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB096, as introduced.

#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to establish additional penalties for individuals convicted for two or more incidents of elder abuse, neglect, or exploitation; and amending Section 53-5-525, MCA.

#### **ASSUMPTIONS:**

- 1. The variable cost for an additional inmate at the Montana State Prison was about \$2,500 per capita in fiscal year 1986.
- 2. There were fewer than 10 cases of elder abuse prosecuted in calendar 1986.
- 3. No data is compiled regarding the fines and sentences imposed regarding cases of elder abuse.

#### FISCAL IMPACT:

The fiscal impact of this law cannot be accurately determined. The cost to the state general fund would depend on the types of sentences given to persons found guilty of abuse of an elderly person.

#### EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUE OR EXPENDITURES:

The fiscal impact of this law on county general funds would depend on the type of sentence given to persons found guilty of elder abuse. There is not sufficient data available to make an accurate fiscal estimate.
